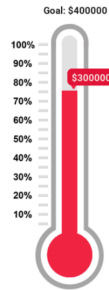

Lost and Found

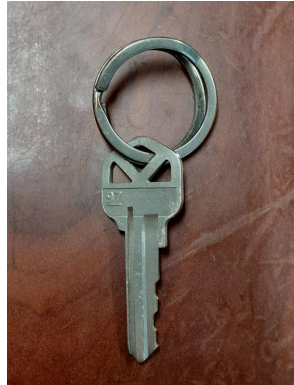
