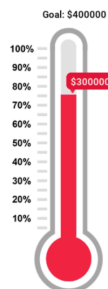

Donations

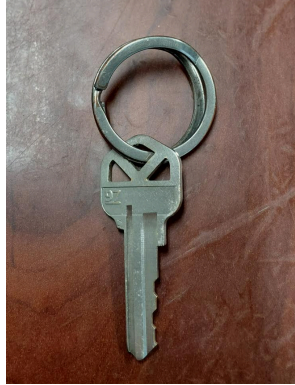
