Teams are headed into the playoffs and regional meets. Praying for safety and success for all of our spring athletes!

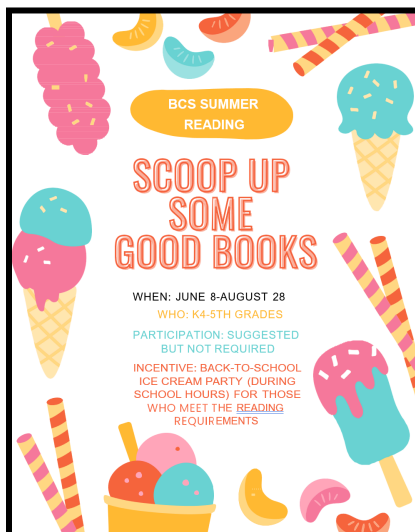
Financial Aid
