

#### **Maine Children's Scholarship Fund Open Enrollment**

The application period is January 1, 2025, and ends on April 30, 2025.

Our random drawing will be in July.

The purpose of the Maine Children's Scholarship Fund is to increase the educational opportunities for the children of low-income families.

MCSF grants help pay for up to seventy-five percent (75%) of the private school tuition (maximum of \$1,400 per child, per year) for families that meet our income guidelines. We have Homeschool and Hybrid scholarships as well.
