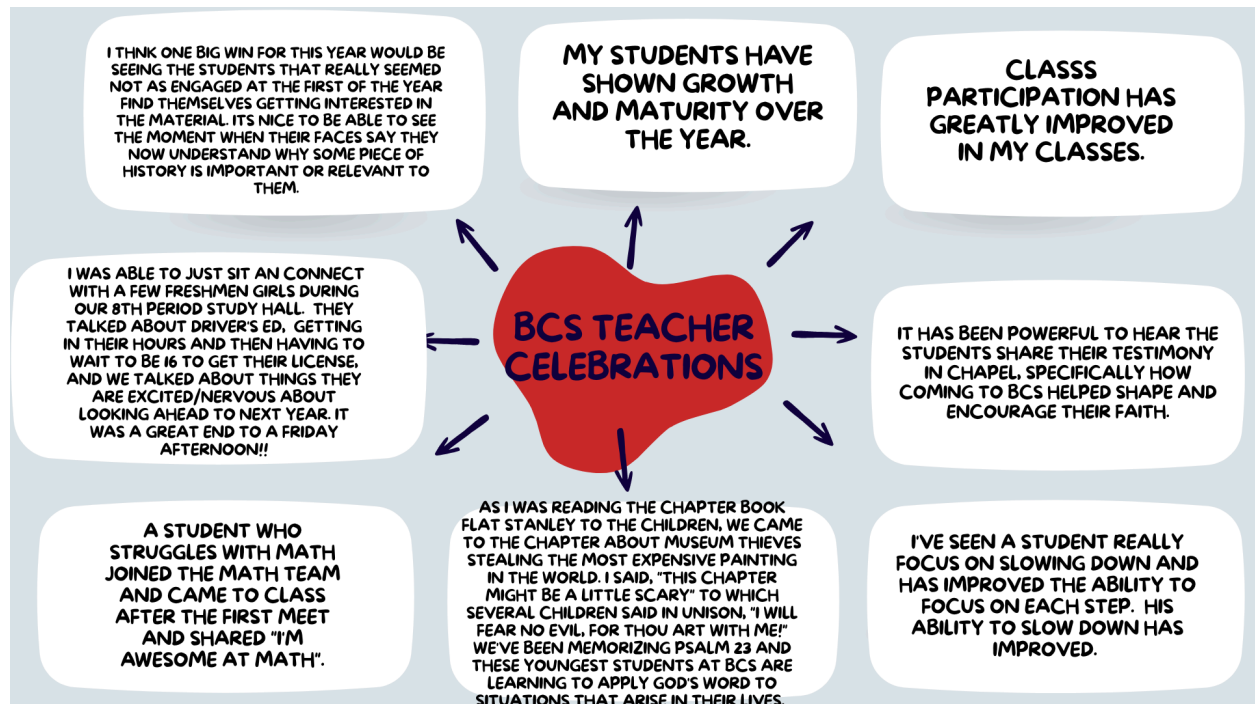
Financial Aid
