### **A Note from Mrs. Vadas on Re-Enrollment**

Re-enrollment works the best on a computer as opposed to a mobile device. Reenrollment **CANNOT** be accessed from BCS website, please go to [www.factsmgt.com/login/](http://www.factsmgt.com/login/) and choose "For Families"  
"Family Portal Log in"  
Our district code is "BCS-ME"  
Enter your username and password

Once you have logged into your Family Portal Account:  
Go to "Apply/Enroll"  
"Enrollment/Reenrollment"  
Start Enrollment Packet"

The enrollment packet will have a menu on the left which will show your progress with green check marks.

The "FACTS Tuition" menu line will say that your agreement is pending, and does not allow you to make changes. The payment plan was renewed with your current plan. If you would like to make changes to your plan, please let me know at [dvadas@bangorchristian.org](mailto:dvadas@bangorchristian.org). We can make changes to your payment plan anytime.

The final menu item is "Enrollment Packet Review". This requires a Preregistration payment of \$52 per student. (Pre registration fee increases to \$105 as of April 1) Once you complete all the items, you will receive a confirmation email. If no email arrives, check your spam folder.

That's it! Your student is enrolled for 2026-27!

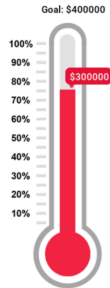

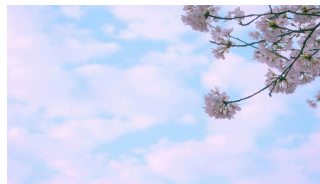

Greetings from Elementary as we look ahead to warmer weather and longer daylight.

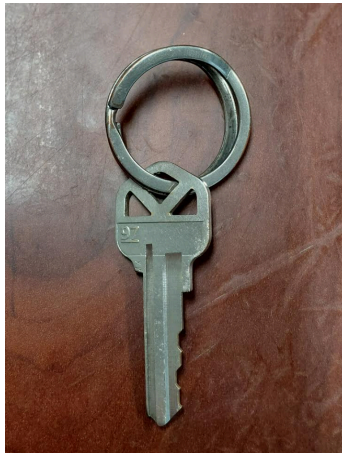
## Lost and Found
